



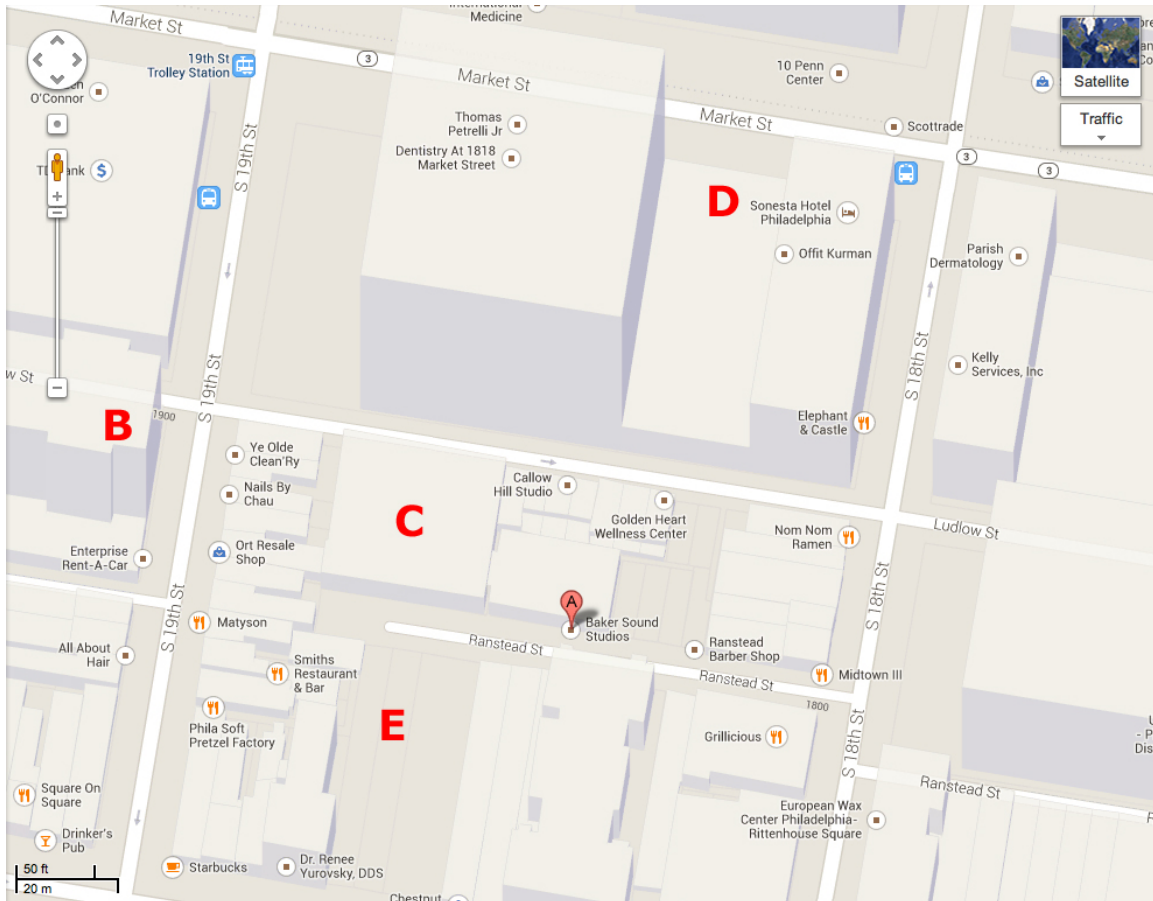

PARKING

Although we do not have a dedicated parking lot, there are a number of convenient parking options in our immediate vicinity. Please refer to the map and instructions below.



A is our location: Baker Sound Studios, in the Musical Art Club building, 1821 Ranstead Street, Philadelphia, PA 19103, Lower Level. There is no parking on Ranstead Street. (Note also that Ranstead Street does not go through from 18th to 19th; however it is possible to drive or walk through the surface lot indicated at **C**.)

B is Central Parking System's public lot at the William Penn House, 36 South 19th Street, between Chestnut and Ludlow (enter from 19th Street). This indoor lot is valet parking only (you leave your keys). This is normally your best option as there is almost always space available. Once you receive your ticket from the attendant, walk directly across 19th Street and through the Parkway surface lot (indicated at **C**). Our building is now directly in front of you.

C is a Parkway public surface lot directly adjacent to our building at 19 South 19th Street (enter from 19th Street). The lot is unattended; you park, pay, and take your keys. This is the closest lot to our building, but there are only about 40 spaces and it tends to fill up quickly, particularly during regular business hours.

D is the LAZ public lot at the Sonesta Hotel, 1800 Market Street (entrance on Market between 18th and 19th). This is another indoor lot with valet parking only (you leave your keys). Once you receive your ticket from the attendant, turn right on Market Street to walk toward 18th, turn right on 18th Street, cross Ludlow, and turn right on Ranstead. Our building will be the last building on the right hand side before the surface lot marked **C**.

E is the E-Z Park surface lot located at 1827 Chestnut Street (enter from Chestnut Street). This lot also serves as parking for Boyd's menswear, and may be full or closed to the public at certain times.

It is also sometimes possible to find street parking along Chestnut between 18th and 19th, or on 18th Street between Chestnut and Market, as well as on other streets in the immediate vicinity.

ACCOMODATIONS
